- A consumer TV that's used as the front-of-room display might cause stability issues in Microsoft Teams Rooms for the following reasons:
  - Inconsistent implementation of standby modes
  - Active video source selection
  - Incorrect EDID information that's communicated to the Microsoft Teams
    Rooms device

Known symptoms include a black or gray screen on the front-of-room display, or the Microsoft Teams Rooms console becomes unresponsive after waking from standby mode. If you experience issues when you use consumer TVs, we recommend that you install a configurable EDID controller or EDID emulator, such as the Kramer PT-1C.
