

2.1 Wall mount (optional): The camera is mounted on the wall using the Lumens VC-WM11 wall mount




2.2 Tripod (optional): The camera is mounted on a 1/4", 20 UNC PTZ tripod deck

#### 3. Cautions for Connection


- 3.1 Power supply
  - 3.1.1 Use the accessory DC12V power adapter for power supply
  - 3.1.2 Use a router or hub (IEEE 802.3 af) that supports power over Ethernet (PoE)
- 3.2 HDMI output
  - 3.2.1 The factory output resolution of VC-BC701P is 4K. Please make sure that the connected display device supports 4K resolution

#### 4. Single-camera Connection

- 4.1 Description for connecting a single camera
  - 4.1.1 IP output: Use the network cables to connect to the computer; output the screen through IP; and control VC-BC701P




4.1.2 HDMI output: Use HDMI to connect to the screen for viewing the images; use the control keyboard to control VC-BC701P through



#### 5. Multi-camera Connection

- 5.1 Description for connecting multiple cameras
  - 5.1.1 Connect multiple units of VC-BC701P, the control keyboard and the computer to the same router; use the control keyboard to control VC-BC701P through IP; and use the computer to view the images



### 6. Start Using

- 6.1 Open the browser, and enter the URL of VC-BC701P in the address bar. Default IP address: 192.168.100.100
- 6.2 Input the administrator account and password to start viewing the camera images and to control the camera
